PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION INTO LL.B. THREE YEAR COURSE (SEMESTER PATTERN)

ACADEMIC SESSION 2019 - 20

The instructions and information given hereunder shall be followed scrupulously.

1. SCHEDULE:

- i) Availability of Online Application : 28/05/2019 (Tuesday)
- ii) Last date for submission of Online Application form : 27/06/2019 (Thursday) or 14 days from the date of publication of +3 results of Berhampur University which ever is later.
- iii) Last date for receipt of Hard Copy of the e-Application Form and required document by Regd./Speed Post : 29/06/2019 (4.30PM) (Saturday)
- iv) Intake Capacity : 160 (One Hundred Sixty)
- v) College Timing : 10.30 AM to 4.30 PM.
(except Sunday and Holidays)

The applicants, before applying to LL.B. (3 Years Semester Pattern) course, are advised to carefully go through the Prospectus and visit the Website <https://www.buodisha.edu.in> or <https://llcbam.blogspot.com> to know about the profile of the College. They are also advised to visit the Premises of Lingaraj Law College and if so desired, they can see for themselves, the available infrastructure and other facilities. If satisfied, they may apply to LL.B. (3 Years Semester Pattern) courses as per their eligibility. Once admitted, making any demand thereafter shall not be entertained and it shall be treated as an act of indiscipline.

2. ADMISSION INTO LL.B. THREE YEAR COURSE (SEMESTER PATTERN)

- i. Admission into the aforementioned course shall be governed by the Regulations of Bar Council of India, Berhampur University and Rules for admission approved by the Syndicate of Berhampur University.
- ii. A candidate whose conduct is not satisfactory shall not be considered for admission.

3. RULES FOR ADMISSION OF FOREIGN STUDENTS:

No candidate from a Foreign country will be considered for admission unless his/her case has been sponsored by the Government of India in the relevant

Department/Ministry. The sponsored candidates are required to produce a Medical Fitness Certificate from a Registered Medical Practitioner not below the rank of a C.D.M.O. in the prescribed proforma within a month of their provisional admission besides other documents required under the rules, instructions of the Government of India/ Odisha. Foreign students who have passed the qualifying examination from a Foreign country taking admission in Lingaraj Law College have to pay Rs.10,000/- along with other fee applicable from time to time. Further a Foreign student passing the qualifying examination from any Indian/ Foreign University will have to come through the Admission Rules.

4. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

Any person who has passed the qualifying Graduate / Degree Examination of Berhampur University or any other examination conducted by other Universities/ Institutions which is recognized as equivalent thereto by Berhampur University and Bar Council of India with **45% of marks (40% marks for candidate belonging to the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes)** in aggregate is eligible for admission into LL.B. course.

Other Criteria: For candidates, who have passed more than one qualifying examination, the examination in which they have secured the highest marks shall be considered for determining eligibility provided they must have secured 45% of marks at Bachelor Degree level.

Selection Criteria of Applicants for Admission: Selection will be made strictly on merit basis taking into consideration the aggregate marks of the qualifying examination.

N.B.: Candidates who have obtained +2 Higher Secondary Pass Certificate or First Degree Certificate after prosecuting studies in Distance or Correspondence method shall also be considered eligible for admission in the Three-year LL.B. Course. However, the applicants who have obtained 10+2 or Graduation/Post Graduation through Open Universities system directly without having any basic qualification for prosecuting such studies are **not** eligible for admission into the Law Course.

5. RESERVATION AND CONCESSIONS :

i. Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes:

38.75% (Thirty Eight and Three fourth) Percent of the sanctioned strength is reserved for candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (S.C. 16.25% and S.T. 22.50%). In order to claim reservation under these categories, applicants must submit necessary certificates to this effect issued only by a **Revenue Officer of the locality not below the rank of a Tahasildar of the Govt. of Odisha.**

ii. Person with Disability(PwD) /Differently abled :

5% of sanctioned seats shall be reserved for PWD students with extent of disability not below 40%(blindness and low vision, hard of hearing, locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid victims and muscular dystrophy, autism intellectual

disability, specific learning disability and mental illness). For availing such reservation the candidate has to submit a certificate from **C.D.M.O.**

iii. Ex-Serviceman [ESM], Serving Defence Personnel [SDP], Children of Martyrs [CoM]

1% of the sanctioned seats shall be reserved for self / Children / Wife / Husband of Ex-Serviceman, Serving Defence Personnel & the Children of Martyrs.

iv. NCC:

i. Applicants holding B Certificate shall be given weightage of additional 5% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the Higher Secondary (+2) or equivalent examination.

ii. Applicants who have represented the State or the Central School/ Sainik School at the All India level NCC Camps/ Courses/ Activities shall be given weightage of additional 3% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the Higher Secondary (+2) or Equivalent Examination.

v.NSS:

i. Applicants who have represented the state at National Level Camp shall be given Weightage of additional 5% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the CHSE/ Equivalent Examination.

ii. Applicants who have represented the inter State Category Camp shall be given weightage of additional 3% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the CHSE/ Equivalent Examination.

iii. Applicants who have got the best NSS Volunteer Award in University level shall be given weightage of additional 2% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured in CHSE/ Equivalent Examination.

vi. Rover & Rangers:

i. Rover & Ranger possessing the original certificate signed by the President of India shall be given weightage of additional 5% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the Higher Secondary (+2)/ Equivalent Examination.

ii. Rover & Rangers possessing and producing the original certificate signed by the Governor/ PATRON/ President of the State Association shall be given weightage of additional 2% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the Higher Secondary (+2)/ Equivalent Examination.

vii. Sports/Games Weightage:

One Seat is reserved for the candidates who have represented the country in the International Games and Sports during last three years for admission into a course. In case of non-availability of such candidates, the reserved seat will be filled from common merit .

(a) Weightage for Sports Persons:

i) Those who have represented the state during last three years at National level sports shall get 10% weightage of marks over and above the aggregate marks in the qualifying examination.

ii) Those who have represented University at the Inter University Sports during last three years shall get 5% weightage of marks over and above the aggregate marks in the qualifying examination.

iii) A weightage of 10% of career points secured by the candidate at the qualifying examination will also be given to those candidates who qualify under (g) above for his/her participation in the International games & sports during last three years, but could not get admission against the direct quota.

Such candidates under category (g) and (h) must submit a certificate to the effect in the proper format (but not in the form of a testimonial) as prescribed by sports bodies, from the Registrar of the University or Secretary Sports Council/State/National level sports bodies duly countersigned by the Head of the Institution/Principal in which the sportsperson was studying at the time of achieving the above distinction(s).

viii. After providing for the reservations stated in (i),(ii),(iii) and (vii) above, 50% of the remaining seats shall be on common merit applicants and rest 50% exclusively for Berhampur University Applicants. Vacancies if arise out of First list and reservation other than SC/ST shall be filled up on common merit.

6. PROCEDURE of e-Payment of Processing-cum-Application Fee:

Procedure for depositing the Processing-cum-Application Fee of Rs. 600/- (Rupees Six hundred only) for General/OBC/SEBC Category candidates and Rs.500/- (Rupees Five hundred) for SC/ST candidates online using State Bank Collect facility. Fees can be deposited through State Bank Collect / SB Collect using Debit Card, Credit Card, Net Banking facility of any Bank besides visiting any SBI branch to deposit by cash or cheque drawn on any SBI Branch. Fees Once deposited shall not be refunded.

Please read the instructions carefully before remitting fees

Visit online banking website of SBI by typing **<https://www.onlinesbi.com>** in the address bar of the browser viz. internet explorer. Once the home page appears click on 'State Bank Collect' tab or click on SBI Collect tab on online admission page.

- Accept the disclaimer clause and click on "Proceed".
- Select the State of Corporate/Institution as 'Odisha'.
- Select type of Corporate/Institution as 'Educational Institutions' and click on 'Go'.
- Now select Educational Institution Name as 'LINGARAJ LAW COLLEGE BERHAMPUR UNIVERSITY' and click on 'Submit'.
- Select the payment category from the drop down as "PROCESSING FEE(LL.B)".
- Before filling the challan, read the Payment Details/Structure Document carefully and ascertain the fees amount applicable to you.
- Fill in the challan with required information as asked for or select from the drop down options wherever available. **Take adequate care while filling in (a) Name (b) Date of Birth & (c) Mobile Number as asked for in the lower part of the screen.**

This information is important to reprint the e-Receipt subsequent to any successful payment.

- Once required data is filled in click on 'Submit'.
- The system will ask you to verify the details entered and confirm the transaction in the next page. Verify the details and click on 'Confirm'.
- The system will request you to select the desired payment mode from various options. Please note that the bank charges for various payment modes are also displayed which is to be borne by the remitter. **Carefully examine the charges displayed since the charges for different payment mode are different. Select the desired payment mode.**
- Now the system will guide the remitter through the payment process. Once the payment is completed successfully one e-Receipt is generated containing a **Reference Number** in PDF format. Take a print out of two copies. You may also save this optionally for future reference. The e-Receipt can also be regenerated/reprinted afterwards from 'Payment History' link of 'State Bank Collect'.

If '**SBI Branch**' is selected as payment mode a Pre Acknowledgement Payment (PAP) form is generated which contains the relevant details for payment at Branch. The payer takes the print out of the PAP Form and visits **any SBI branch** for payment through **cash or cheque drawn on SBI Branch**. After the payment is successfully processed by the branch, the branch will give an acknowledgment of payment on the PAP Form. Now any time the payer may optionally return to 'State Bank Collect' link in the home page of www.onlinesbi.com for printing the e-receipt from the 'Payment History' link.

N.B. : Money Order and Postal Order or any other form of deposits shall not be accepted under any circumstances.

7. e-Application PROCEDURE:

e-Admission system has been adopted by the College for admission into the LL.B. Course for the academic session 2019-2020. The Applicants are advised to submit the e-application from well in advance without waiting the closing date to avoid last rush. The procedure of e-admission is as follows:

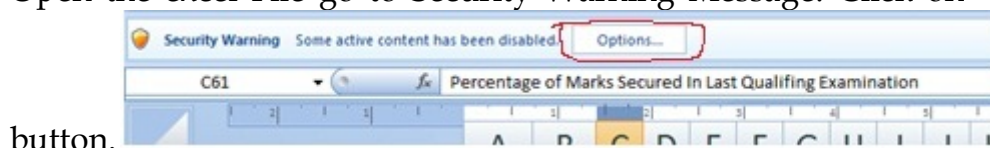
- i. The Following documents must be made ready before starting the Application process:*
 - The applicant should Deposit **Processing-cum-Application Fee** through State Bank Collect as per the instructions mentioned at **Sl. No. 6.**at above. **Then take a printout of e-receipt of State Bank Collect and keep one soft copy of the e-receipt.**

- Soft copy of your **State Bank Collect Reference number** deposited towards **Processing-cum-Application Fee**.
- Scanned copy of your recent passport size photograph in JPG Format, 100KB in size.
- Scanned copy of Caste Certificate.
- Scanned copy of your signature in JPG format.
- In case the marks are in Grade convert to equivalent percentage for 10th / +2/UG/PG Level and write 1st class / 2nd class / 3rd class.
- Candidate should have valid and active Phone Number and e-mail ID.

ii. submission of application :

Step 3: Fill the form and attach all Documents. Click on “Submit” Button. You will get a conformation message into your e-mail.

iii. Take two copies of the hardcopy of Filled in ADMISSION Form (excel format). The first copy of admission form duly signed by the applicant must be submitted to the **PRINCIPAL, LINGARAJ LAW COLLEGE, BERHAMPUR, GANJAM, ODISHA, PIN-760010** by **Speed Post / Registered Post** so as to reach the college

on or before the last date *i.e.* 29/06/2019 (4.30PM) (Saturday). *The envelope must be superscribed as "Application for Admission into LL.B. (3 Year Course) and SB Collect Reference No. _____ and Date"*. The other copy of the Admission Form should be with the Student. The application should be accompanied by the following documents:

- a) One recent passport size colour photograph duly attested by gazetted officer.
- b) Self-attested copies of all mark sheets and certificates of all the examinations passed (HSC or equivalent, Intermediate/+2, B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. /B.Tech./ B.I.T. / M.B.B.S./+3 Degree/P.G. Degree, etc.). Candidates should submit copies of the mark-sheets/certificates of all the years.
- c) Self attested copies of certificate(s) in support of claim, if any, for a seat against the reserved quota as specified in item (05) of the application form.
- d) Self-attested copy of Registration Receipt (for Berhampur University candidates). Attested copy of the Migration Certificate of the students of other Universities.
- e) e-receipt of State Bank Collect deposited towards **Processing-cum-Application Fee**.
- f) Self attested copy of the CLC and Conduct Certificate of the Head of the Institution last attended.

Provisional List

- iv. Those Applicants are selected in **Provisional List** for Admission into 3 Years LL.B. Course, after receiving the intimation letter for admission through e-mail to the registered e-mail ID and by post from Office of the Principal. The candidate should personally attend before the Admission Committee with the following **documents in original** on the intimated date including State Bank Collect e-receipt deposited towards **Admission Fee**.

- l) Submit an affidavit in a non-judicial stamp paper as per the prescribed proforma enclosed in the prospectus, **if admitted**.

Wait List

- v. Those Applicants selected in **Waiting List** for Admission into 3 Year LL.B. Course, after receiving intimation letter through e-mail to their registered e-mail ID and by Post they shall follow the same procedure for admission as laid down in para (iv) above. However, for Applicant in Waiting List, admission is not guaranteed. They would be admitted in order of merit in case vacancies arise within the date prescribed.
 - vi. The receipt of admission form hard copy by the college, and Intimation (if selected for Provisional or Wait List) will be intimated through the registered e-mail to their e-mail ID.
 - vii. Failure to take admission on the date and time specified in the Intimation sent through e-mail to their registered e-mail ID and by post shall result in forfeiture of the seat.
 - viii. The decision of the Principal of the College in all matters relating to the admission shall be final.
 - ix. If the applicant submits wrong e-mail ID or wrong postal address, the college will not be responsible for not getting intimation. So the applicant must be careful while submitting the same.
 - x. Hard copy of Application received after the due date and time shall not be entertained and the college/office will not be held responsible for any postal delay.
